Items we need to collect over the course of the summer are: **70-sheet notebooks, 30-centimeter rulers, rulers with centimeters on one edge and inches on the other, pencil sharpeners, blunt scissors, unsharpened pencils, black or blue ballpoint pens, boxes of 16 or 24 crayons, and 2.5 inch block erasers. These items can be placed in the marked bin in the lobby.**

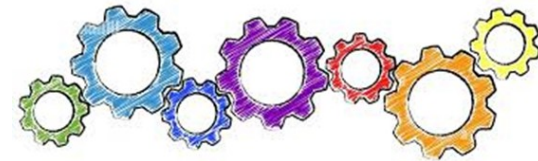
