### **HEARING ASSISTANCE**

Even with hearing aids, many in our congregation find it difficult to hear all parts of the Sunday worship service. The Property Team is looking at ways to solve this problem.

The simplest and most cost effective solution uses Bluetooth technology paired with a cell phone app. The phone acts as a receiver for the audio and sends it to your hearing aids. But this works only if the hearing aids are Bluetooth capable.
