



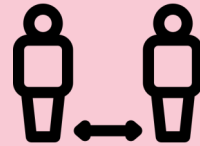

Your Guide for Sunday Morning In-Person Worship



In-person worship has resumed on Sunday morning with one liturgy at 9:30 a.m. Livestream worship continues for those who are in at-risk populations or who wish to continue to avoid large gatherings. NOTE: Those attending in person may be seen on the broadcast.



Physical distancing is at the discretion of those attending. Please be mindful of persons who may be especially vulnerable or who are hesitant about being in crowded spaces. Be prepared to give space to one another as needed.



Enter and exit the building via the narthex or the office lobby door. If you would like to visit with friends and guests before worship, please do so outside before entering the building (weather permitting). This significantly reduces the possibility of air-borne transmission vs. the more crowded and less well ventilated spaces in the narthex and the office lobby.



Hand sanitizer will be located near all doors and throughout the sanctuary. You are encouraged to sanitize your hands upon entry and after any physical contact.



Upon entry, you will be encouraged to do the following:

- **Sanitize your hands**—a hand sanitizing station will be set-up near the entry doors.
- **Put on your mask**— this is a must to help accommodate our sanctuary space which

does not permit frequent or thorough air exchange.

- **Pick up your communion cup**—We will be using a pouring chalice for distribution of the wine. Small cups will be distributed at both entrances. Please pick one up on your way in.



Please note these additional items:

- There will be no congregational singing during the liturgy. There will be other music (vocal and instrumental) offered by the worship leaders.
- Printed copies of the bulletin will be available.

An electronic version is available for download on your own mobile device or download it from the website and print it at home to bring with you.

- We will not pass offering plates. Offering plates will be placed near the sanctuary doors to receive our tithes and gifts.
- Restrooms are available for use; two persons at a time are permitted.
- The nursery will not be open and child care is not available.
- Fellowship time after worship will be held on the north lawn (weather permitting).
- Please be aware that by entering the Sanctuary, you consent to your voice, name, and/or likeness being used, without compensation, in photography and video for exploitation in any and all media, whether now known or hereafter devised, for eternity, and you release Holy Trinity Lutheran Church, its successors, assigns and licensees from any liability whatsoever of any nature. By entering beyond this point, you agree to be subject to the foregoing.



Masks must be worn by those not leading the liturgy. Please bring your own mask; only a limited supply will be available at the building. If you cannot or will not wear a mask, please worship at home via the livestream.



Seating in the Sanctuary is open on a first-come, first-serve basis beginning from the front of the nave. Those who are concerned about physical distancing are welcome to sit apart from others. All persons are asked to respect each other's desire for appropriate space.

All public areas and high touch objects/surfaces will be thoroughly cleaned and sanitized before and after all in-person activities.

Beyond Sunday worship:

Small groups, ministry teams, committees, and studies are permitted to meet in the building, but are encouraged to continue meeting online when possible. Meetings must be scheduled with the parish secretary at least two days prior so that the meeting space may be cleaned/sanitized before and after.
