#### **DLM Collection Drives**

Some of the most needed items for the families served by DLM are hygiene products. On each Sunday in October, donations of personal care items are being collected. - October 9 hygiene products for infants and children up to age 11 (shampoo, conditioner, body wash, lotion, toothpaste, toothbrushes, etc.)
- October 16 hygiene products for teens and adults (body wash/soap, lotion, deodorant, toothpaste, toothbrushes, etc.)
- October 23 underwear for children, size 4T to child x-large
- October 30 underwear for teens and adults, size small to 3x-large

DLM Food & Resources has been open for five years ... five years! To showcase how this ministry has evolved and transformed into what it is today, a special photographic exhibition has been created and is on display in the Chapel Lounge throughout the month of October. We invite you to look back to the beginning in 2017 when two rooms on the lower level were renovated and gave way to DLM Food & Resources.



The exhibition also includes a special tribute to Debra L. Manteghi who DLM was created in honor of and was named after. As the director of Project Rise, Debra lived out her passion for serving those who were experiencing homelessness, especially children. A long-time member of Holy Trinity, Debra envisioned a ministry that provided some of the basic necessities to the students and families she served ... a ministry that offered information and connections to other available community resources ... a ministry that treated people with dignity and

respect. DLM was formed from her vision and for the past five years, it has helped to provide food, personal care items, clothing and resource information to more than 200 families each month.





DLM FOOD & RESOURCES ROOM ... Holy Trinity, in partnership with Project RISE and In One Piece, has transformed room 100 into the new DLM Food & Resources Room ... in memory of member Debra Manteghi. And, what a transformation it has been! Both rooms have a new fresh coat of paint. One side serves as the waiting area (pictured below) and has been fitted with tables and chairs. The other side will serve as the food pantry, and the space now has new shelving that's filled with food that will be given to families involved with Project RISE.
