



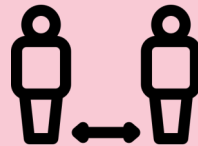

Your Guide for Sunday Morning In-Person Worship



In-person worship continues on Sunday morning with one liturgy at 9:30 a.m. Livestream worship continues for those who are in at-risk populations or who wish to continue to avoid large gatherings. NOTE: Those attending in person may be seen on the broadcast.



You must observe 6' physical distancing upon entry into and exit from the building and while in the Sanctuary.



Enter and exit the building via the narthex or the office lobby door. You are welcome to visit with friends and guests before worship, inside or outside the building (weather permitting). Doors will be left open (weather permitting) to aid in the flow and circulation of air in the Sanctuary.



Hand sanitizer is located near all doors and throughout the sanctuary. You are encouraged to sanitize your hands as needed upon entry.



Upon entry, you will be encouraged to **sanitize your hands**, a hand sanitizing station will be set-up near the entry doors. During communion, the wine and grape juice will continue to be served by communion assistants who will be masked.



Please note these additional items:

- Printed copies of the bulletin will be available. An electronic version is available for download on your own mobile device or download it from the website and print it at home to bring with you.
- Offering plates are near the sanctuary doors to receive your tithes and gifts.
- The nursery remains closed and child care is not available.
- For upcoming fellowship and service activities, face masks are optional. Please look for more information in the Midweek Word and in the Highlights.
- Please be aware that by entering the Sanctuary, you consent to your voice, name, and/or likeness being used, without compensation, in photography and video for exploitation in any and all media, whether now known or hereafter devised, for eternity, and you release Holy Trinity Lutheran Church, its successors, assigns and licensees from any liability whatsoever of any nature. By entering beyond this point, you agree to be subject to the foregoing.



Face masks are optional.

Those who are immune-compromised or simply desire additional protection are welcome and encouraged to continue to wear a mask or face covering.



Seating is at your own discretion. Please be mindful of persons who may be especially vulnerable or who are hesitant about being in crowded spaces. Be prepared to give space to one another as needed.

All public areas and high touch objects/surfaces will continue to be cleaned and sanitized before and after all in-person activities.

Beyond Sunday worship:

Small groups, ministry teams, committees, and studies are permitted to meet in person and/or hybrid format at the church, or are welcome to continue meeting virtually. **FACE MASKS ARE OPTIONAL.**

Meetings must be scheduled with the parish secretary at least two days prior so that the meeting space may be cleaned/sanitized before and after.
